

靜宜大學國際生免修華語課程作業要點

民國 112 年 05 月 24 日教務會議通過

一、因應大學多元化入學，及若干國際生對華語已具相當程度，為整合資源、減少授課與學習的困擾，特訂定「國際生免修華語課程作業要點」(以下簡稱本作業要點)。

二、本校之大一國際新生或轉學生得依華語文能力測驗(以下簡稱 TOCFL)、快篩成績或漢語水平考試(以下簡稱 HSK)之成績申請免修華語課程如下：

- (1)TOCFL 測驗結果如通過入門級(LEVEL 1) / HSK 測驗結果如通過 Basic 1 得免修中文 101。
- (2)TOCFL 測驗結果如通過基礎級(LEVEL 2) / HSK 測驗結果如通過 Basic 2, 3 得免修中文 101、中文 102、初級華語聽力與口說(一)及初級華語閱讀與書寫(一)。
- (3)TOCFL 測驗結果如通過進階級(LEVEL 3) / HSK 測驗結果如通過 Elementary 3, 4, 5 得免修中文 101、中文 102、中文 201、中文 202、初級華語聽力與口說(一)、(二)及初級華語閱讀與書寫(一)、(二)。
- (4)TOCFL 測驗結果如通過高階級(LEVEL 4) / HSK 測驗結果如通過 Intermediate 6, 7, 8 得免修所有華語課程。

- 四、凡申請免修華語課程者，需於第一階段選課前繳交 TOCFL 或 HSK 證書至國際處之國際學生組，並向華語文教學中心提出申請。
- 五、免修資料由華語文教學中心主任與國際長審核，審核通過且經教務長核准後，由綜合業務組登錄免修，不計學分，唯該生仍須修畢該系最低畢業學分數(含抵免學分)，方可畢業。
- 六、本作業要點需經全球事務委員會通過，並經教務會議通過後公告施行，同時提報教育部備查，修正時亦同。

Chinese Language Credit Exemption Criteria for International Students

1. Recognizing that some students have achieved a high level of proficiency in Chinese and that there are many universities offering Chinese language courses, the Chinese Language Education Center (CLEC) has established the “Chinese Language Credit Exemption Criteria for International Students”, also known as the Waiver Criteria, to alleviate difficulties in course teaching and learning.
2. International freshmen or transfer students of our school can apply for exemption from Mandarin courses based on the following TOCFL, Speedy Screening, or HSK scores:
 - (1) Students who pass the TOCFL A1 (LEVEL 1) or Basic 1 of the HSK are exempted from taking Chinese 101.
 - (2) Students who pass the TOCFL A2 (LEVEL 2) or Basic 2 and 3 of the HSK are exempted from taking Chinese 101, Chinese 102, Elementary Chinese Listening and Speaking (I), and Elementary Chinese Reading and Writing (I).
 - (3) Students who pass the TOCFL B1 (LEVEL 3) or Elementary 3, 4, 5 of the HSK are exempted from taking Chinese 101, Chinese 102, Chinese 201, Chinese 202, Elementary Chinese Listening and Speaking (I) and (II), and Elementary Chinese Reading and Writing (I) and (II).
 - (4) Students who pass the TOCFL B2 (LEVEL 4) or Intermediate 6, 7, 8 of the HSK are exempted from taking all Mandarin courses.

TOCFL A2 (LEVEL 2) or Basic 2 and 3 of the HSK	Chinese 101, Chinese 102, Basic Chinese Listening and Speaking I, And Basic Chinese Reading and Writing I
TOCFL B1 (LEVEL 3) or Elementary 3, 4, 5 of the HSK	Chinese 101, Chinese 102, Chinese 201, Chinese 202, Basic Chinese Listening and Speaking I and II, and Basic Chinese Reading and Writing I and II
TOCFL B2 (LEVEL 4) or Intermediate 6, 7, 8 of the HSK	All Mandarin courses exempted.

Students may also apply for exemption from Chinese language courses based on the Chinese Language Entrance Examination for International Students at our university. The corresponding courses that can be exempted based on the test results are as follows:

Test Results	Exempted Mandarin Courses
Entrance Examination 11-26 points	Chinese 101
Entrance Examination 27-44 points	Chinese 101, Chinese 102
Entrance Examination 45-60 points	Chinese 101, Chinese 102, Chinese 201, Basic Chinese Listening and Speaking I, And Basic Chinese Reading and Writing I
Entrance Examination 61-76 points	Chinese 101, Chinese 102, Chinese 201, Chinese 202, Basic Chinese Listening and Speaking I, and Basic Chinese Reading and Writing I
Entrance Examination 77-92 points	Chinese 101, Chinese 102, Chinese 201, Chinese 202, Chinese 301, Basic Chinese Listening and Speaking I and II, and Basic Chinese Reading and Writing I and II
Entrance Examination 93-108 points	Chinese 101, Chinese 102, Chinese 201, Chinese 202, Chinese 301, Chinese 302, Basic Chinese Listening and Speaking I and II, and Basic Chinese Reading and Writing I and II
Entrance Examination 109-120 points	All Mandarin courses exempted.

3. Students seeking exemption from Chinese language courses must submit their TOCFL or HSK certificate to the International and Cross-Strait Affairs Office (OIA) Division of International and Overseas Students Affairs prior to the first course selection period and apply to the Chinese Language Education Center.
4. The exemption application will be reviewed by the Director of the Chinese Language Education Center and the Dean of the Office of International Affairs. Once approved, the exemption will be registered by the Comprehensive Business Group and no credit will be counted towards the student's graduation. However, the student still needs to complete the minimum graduation credits of their major (including exempted credits) to graduate.
